	If you were to open this account with £50,000 and no further deposits or withdrawals were made you would earn £500 interest. This would result in a total balance of £50,500.

How do I open and manage my account?				
Who is eligible?	This account is available to existing and new customers over the age of 16 who are personal savers resident in the UK.			
How do I operate my account?	Any queries regarding your account can be dealt with via branch, email or telephone. Instructions on your account are required in person at branch or in writing.			
How do I open my savings account?	You may open your account at any one of our branches or via post.			
What is my minimum opening and operating balance?	£1,000	What is my maximum operating balance?	£500,000	
What is my maximum investment?	£500,000			
Can I withdraw money?	65 days' notice is required; or 65 days' interest will be forfeited on the amount withdrawn. This penalty will be deducted from your accrued interest. If you have insufficient accrued interest to cover the penalty due, the remaining amount will be deducted from your account balance on closing your account or when your interest is next due to be added to it. If the balance falls below £1,000, the account will automatically revert to the Dudley Building Society Instant Tracker Account.
